

FFCC Board of Directors

Qualifications & Expectations

QUALIFICATIONS: Per the FFCC's Articles of Incorporation, persons wishing to pursue nomination onto the FFCC Board of Directors **MUST** fall into at least one of the following categories.

- Actively serving as a designated team representative for no less than three (3) consecutive years prior to nomination.
- A qualified adjudicator in good standing for no less than three (3) consecutive years prior to nomination.
- A certified Contest Staff member for no less than three (3) consecutive years prior to nomination.
- A member of the Board of Directors for no less than three (3) consecutive years prior to nomination.

EXPECTATIONS: Persons interested in pursuing a Board nomination, must be willing and able to serve the FFCC Membership in an active, working role. This includes:

- **Board Meetings** - Willingness to serve as active participants in the annual face-to-face meetings at the conclusion of the competitive season, over the summer for budget planning and in the fall for show selection and pre-season preparations.
- **Online Meetings** - Availability to meet virtually for meetings throughout the year for check-ins regarding events, capital needs, various issues that may arise, etc.
- **Board Role** - Ability to fulfill the responsibilities designated during the Summer Meeting based on talents & abilities. The FFCC Board of Directors is a "working" board that requires personal time spent with individuals overseeing and managing projects assigned to them. (See Board of Directors responsibilities chart for examples)
- **FFCC Championships** - All members of the Board of Directors are expected to be hands-on in the planning process and the on-site execution of the FFCC Championships event weekend.
