

## **Criteria for Hall of Fame Candidates**

The FFCC Hall of Fame recognizes individuals in the winter guard, winter percussion, and winds activities that have contributed most significantly to the standards and direction of the Organization. Selection to the FFCC Hall of Fame can be achieved as a designer, a director, or other administrative position such as adjudicator, or FFCC Board Member. The following criteria will be used when evaluating potential Hall of Fame members:

### **DESIGNERS**

- Meritorious contributions
- Influence on winter guard, percussion, or winds within the FFCC
- Depth of service
- Length of service
- Support of FFCC educational programs and/or committees
- Service to FFCC community at large

### **FFCC ADMINISTRATIVE OR TEAM DIRECTORS**

- Meritorious contributions
- Influence on winter guard, percussion, or winds within the FFCC
- Depth of service
- Length of service
- Support of FFCC educational programs and/or committees
- Service to FFCC community at large
- Service to FFCC Board of Directors

### **ADJUDICATORS**

- Meritorious contributions
- Influence on winter guard, percussion, or winds within the FFCC
- Depth of service
- Length of service

- Support of FFCC educational programs and/or committees
- Service to FFCC community at large
- Success in design or improvement of the judging system

While listed in several areas of the criteria, it should be noted that the length of service should be considered in combination with other areas of achievement for an individual to be considered for selection to the FFCC Hall of Fame. Individuals should be considered for their achievements. It is important to only consider the merits of the criteria.
